


Proposals of the Conference on the Future of Europe #EBDGrafik

Consistency with EM Germany's political priorities 2021/22*



Important to EM Germany with regard to implementation

- The EU institutions should follow up on the proposals in a timely manner and make full use of all the possibilities offered by the treaties - including the passerelle clauses (esp. Art 48 (7) TEU) that allow to abolish unanimity in the Council in most policy fields
- At the same time, member states and the Commission should support the EP in convening a European Convention and open the debate for treaty changes**
- European party families should use proposals as political momentum for the 2024 European elections

* The proposals were adopted by the plenary assembly of the Conference on the Future of Europe on 29 April 2022 and approved by the Executive Committee on 6 May 2022 after minor amendments.
